- Determine paint flow and coating quality by performing first piece visual inspections of parts prior to and after curing oven
- Bake parts at appropriate temperatures within time limitations
- Utilize instrumentation to measure painting parameters to ensure compliance with established goals for quality
- Maintain a clean and safe work environment and observe good safety habits
- Hang unpainted parts on and take painted parts off conveyor line
